Cambridge Street is the heart of eastern Cambridge, a major retail center, and one of the city's busiest streets.

In 2024, the City of Cambridge plans to:

- Install quick-build separated bike lanes on one mile of Cambridge Street between Inman Square and Second Street.
- Make improvements for people walking and riding transit.

This project will:

- Change the layout of the street with new pavement markings, traffic signs, and flex posts.
- Reconstruct curb ramps.
- Reduce the number of on-street parking spaces. We will work with businesses and residents to identify the best locations and regulations for remaining parking.
- Accomodate outdoor street dining.
- Evaluate changes to improve bus service.
