

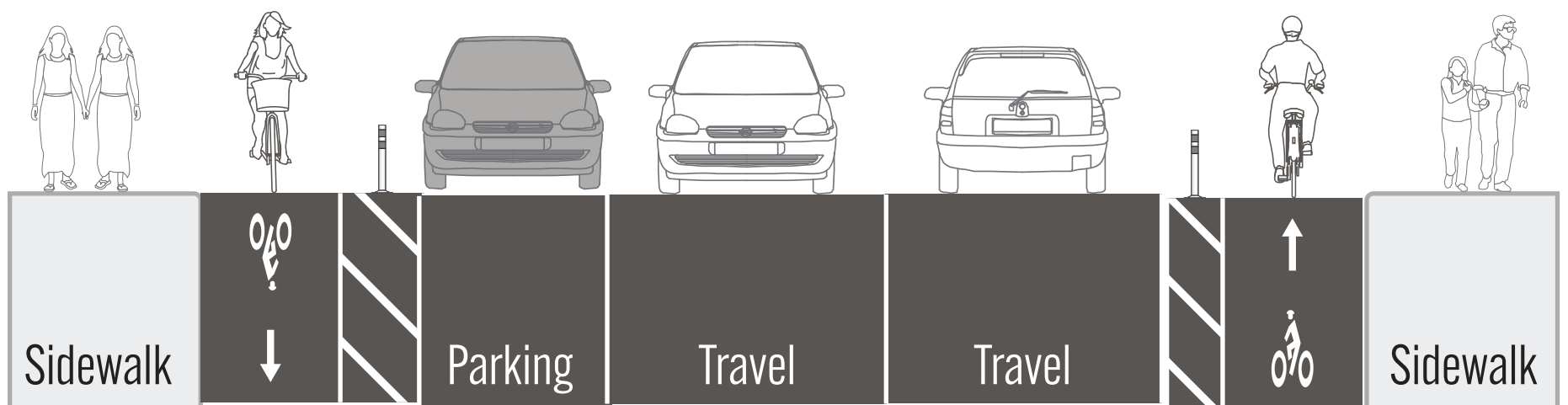
SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ON CAMBRIDGE STREET

WHAT WILL CHANGE?

New separated bike lanes, significantly less parking

In 2024, the City of Cambridge plans to add separated bike lanes and make related safety improvements on Cambridge Street. What do we know about the project so far?

Typical Street Layout



Separated bike lanes

We will move bike lanes against the curb and separate them from moving vehicles with white flex posts.

Reduced on-street parking

We will reduce parking along the street by about half. There will be on-street parking spaces on one side of the street. The side of the street that parking is on can switch back and forth.

Curb ramp updates

We will reconstruct curb ramps along the street to meet ADA standards.

Quick-build materials

We will use quick-build materials—paint, flex posts, and changes to signs and signals. These allow us to make changes without a seasons-long or years-long construction process.
