The law requires that all dogs six months or older be licensed annually. The license period runs from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.

Licenses cannot be issued to persons under 18 years of age.

To license a dog, please provide the following:

- 1. Current rabies vaccination certificate or medical records with an expiration date (copies are sufficient)
- 2. Proof of spay or neuter if not shown before
- 3. Proof of Cambridge residency (a utility bill dated in last 30 days or 2 pieces of mail with name and address)
- 4. If licensing by mail include A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE.

(There will be up to a \$25 fee for any returned checks, and your dog will not be considered licensed until payment is made).

PLEASE READ: Check the Service Animal Box **only** if your dog is a Service Animal as defined under the American With Disabilities Act (ADA). This means any dog that is individually trained to **do work or perform tasks** for the benefit of an individual with a disability. The work or tasks performed by a service animal **must** be directly related to the handler's disability.
