

Restroom Policy

Public restrooms are available at all Cambridge Public Library locations. We support your ability to use the restroom that corresponds with your gender identity.

All-gender restrooms and restroom stalls are single occupancy, except when being used by caregivers with children.

Please note the following:

- Keys are required to access some all-gender restrooms. You may request keys at the nearest service desk. Please return the key to library staff at the service desk after use; do not pass the key to another patron.
- You may use the restroom for up to 15 minutes. After 15 minutes, staff will knock on the door to check on your wellbeing and to ensure the restroom is available for other patrons.
- Library staff will call 911 if there is no response or if there is any indication of an unsafe situation.
- You must also follow all other library policies while using library restrooms.

Reasonable accommodations may be made for persons with disabilities.
