To Have Your Taxes Done You MUST Bring:

- Your Social Security Card²
- Government Issued Photo ID (driver's license, etc.)
- Social Security Cards for all your dependents³
- Any tax forms you have received (W-2, 1099-HC, etc.)

¹ The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers free tax help to people who generally make \$58,000 or less, persons with disabilities, the elderly and limited English speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their tax returns.

² Or other government issued ID showing your social security number. A W-2 is NOT sufficient.

³ And spouse if filing a joint return.

- Please note: due to capacity constraints and training requirements, we will be unable to prepare returns for any taxpayers in the U.S. on a visa, including foreign students and teachers.
