- Ms. Calioro welcomed the attendees.
- The meeting started with a connection: What strategies have people used to get kids to talk about their day. Responses varied from Bedtime, dinner, reading body language-excitement, anything around food,
- Meeting minutes were approved for June 2025 and September 2025.
- Ms. Calioro is serving as acting principal, Ms. Blair is serving as acting Asst. Principal. Brief bios for both leaders were shared, you can review them in the slide show.
- MC reiterated that the transition has been fairly smooth. Council members asked where support might be needed at this time, especially from the community. MC recounted that the first week was smooth, and received support from the upper school principals and district support (Asst superintendent). PAUS has a great team - office staff, teachers, counselors, liaison etc. jump in when they need to.
- A question was asked: what change if any do we anticipate in the next month and a half? Response: we anticipate school functioning as usual without a glitch, based on adequate planning with Dr. Babio-James & Ms. Calioro. We are trained and prepared for this, and have the right teams to support the school during this time.
- Staff SC Member PJ spoke about the 30 PAUS 8th graders who attended an International Colloquium at the Peace Institute at Wellesley, Harvard and MIT. Scholars represented PAUS and participated in discussions with UN Leaders, Dignitaries, Politicians and Entrepreneurs from around the world, in areas of Peace, Advocacy and Youth Leadership.
- A caregiver asked if there will be a theme for the SC meetings moving forward? Yes! Despite the transition, we wanted to keep the October SC meeting, introduce the leadership to the community, and shared highlights and updates (see slideshow).
- PAUS FunRun-Walk was introduced, along with the PAFA Fundraiser to support Putnam Ave. Panthers, athletics dept.
- Meeting ended at 7:00pm
