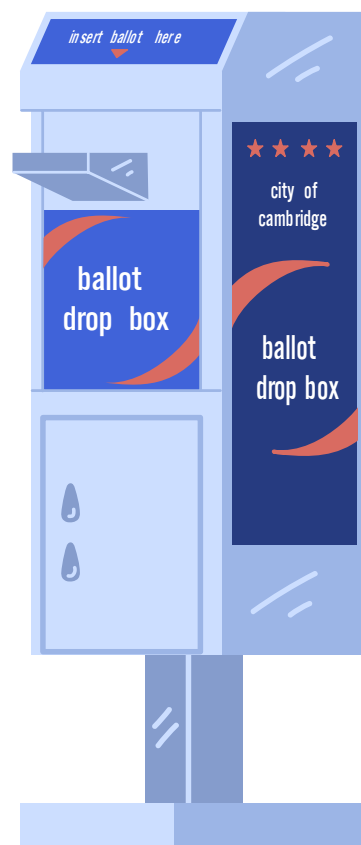
3 Early Voting Locations Throughout Cambridge

Official Ballot Drop Box Locations

(For Cambridge voters only)

- 1. City Hall:** Near the back door of the building located at 795 Massachusetts Avenue
- 2. Morse School:** Near the front entrance of the building located at 40 Granite Street
- 3. Cambridge Police Headquarters:** Near the front of the building located at 125 6th Street
- 4. Maria L. Baldwin School:** Right-side of the Oxford Street Entrance of the building located at 85 Oxford Street
- 5. O'Neill Library:** Adjacent to the entrance stairs of the building located at 70 Rindge Avenue
- 6. Coffon Building:** Right-side of the front of the building located at 51 Inman Street

If you do not have a Registry of Motor Vehicles ID, you will need to print your registration form and mail it to the Election Commission Office at 51 Inman St, Cambridge MA, 02139.

In Person:

Cambridge Election Commission, 51 Inman Street, Cambridge, MA 02139 during regular office hours.

On Saturday, October 29th, you may register at any of the Early Voting Locations from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. or at the Election Commission office from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

UNDERSTANDING EARLY VOTING



What is Early Voting?

Early Voting is an opportunity to vote before Election Day. You can vote in-person or by mail, and your ballot will be cast for you on Election Day. The early voting period is set by Massachusetts State Law.

Who can vote early?

Any registered voter in Cambridge can vote during the early voting period! Unlike absentee voting, you don't need an excuse or reason to vote early!

Where can I vote early?

Unlike Election Day, you are not assigned to a polling location. You can go to any of the Cambridge Early Voting Locations detailed below. **The Election Commission office** located at 51 Inman Street will NOT be an early voting location for the State Election.

When can I vote early?

The Early Voting Period is from Saturday, October 22nd through Friday, November 4th. The times vary from day to day so check out the schedule below.

What if I want to vote on Election Day instead?

If you don't vote early, you can still vote at your assigned polling location on Election Day.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT YOUR POLLING LOCATION MAY HAVE CHANGED.

You will receive a voter notification with your assigned location prior to Election Day, or you can look it up at www.cambridgema.gov/pollinglocations. Polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8th. You can only vote once—if you cast an early voting ballot, you cannot vote on Election Day.

The **Election Commission office** located at 51 Inman Street **will NOT** be an early voting location for the State Election. Voters must go to one of the designated early voting locations listed above.



EARLY VOTING BY MAIL

Important Deadlines

Deadline to request a ballot: *Tuesday, November 1st at 5 p.m.*
The Election Commission recommends applying as early as possible to ensure timely delivery.

Deadline to return ballots by drop box or in person: *Tuesday, November 8th at 8 p.m.*

Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Election Day and received by the Election Commission office by *Saturday, November 12th at 5 p.m.*

Download an application from www.MailMyBallotMA.com or send a written request for a ballot with your name, Cambridge address, address where you want the ballot sent, and your signature.

Send your signed application by email, fax, or mail. If you're emailing your application, you need to sign it in a way that can be compared to your hand-written signature. Electronic signatures, scanned applications, and photos of applications are acceptable. Typed signatures cannot be accepted.

Options for returning your ballot:

- Return the ballot by mail using the postage-paid envelope provided with your ballot
- Return the sealed ballot envelope to an election official at a designated early voting location during prescribed early voting hours
- Deliver your ballot to any one of the six (6) ballot drop boxes located in Cambridge. Drop box locations are listed on the back page of this guide. The drop boxes are available from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. every day until Election Day on Tuesday, November 8th at 8 p.m.
