2023 Municipal Election Calendar

<u>July 3</u> :	Municipal Election Nomination Papers available at Election Commission office.
July 31 :	5 p.m. deadline to submit nomination papers & statements of financial interest for candidates.
August 14:	5 p.m. deadline for Election Commission to certify signatures on nomination papers.
August 16:	5 p.m. deadline for municipal candidates to file withdrawal of nomination.
<u>October 28</u> :	5 p.m. deadline to register to vote in municipal election. In person registration hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Election Commission office. (Mail-in registration must be postmarked by October 28th).
<u>October 30</u> :	Deadline for <u>School Committee</u> candidates and <u>Political Committees</u> to file Municipal Campaign & Political Finance Reports. (<u>City Council</u> candidates should consult their OCPF packets regarding depository-filing requirements).
October 31:	5 p.m. deadline to request a ballot by mail.
<u>November 6</u> :	Noontime (12 p.m.) deadline to apply for absentee ballot for over-the-counter voting.
November 7.	Municipal Floction Polls are open 7 a m until 8 n m

 <u>November 7</u>: Municipal Election. Polls are open 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. All vote-by-mail ballots (except overseas absentee ballots) must arrive at the Election Commission <u>office</u> by 8 p.m. to be counted. Ballot count begins at Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue, Central Square after the polls close. Overseas absentee ballots are due by 5 p.m. on Friday, November 17th, but must be postmarked by November 7th.

November 8: 9 a.m. Ballot count resumes at Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue, Central Square.

November 17: Overseas absentee ballots and provisional ballots will be counted at 5 p.m.

In-person early voting and drop box locations and hours will be posted online at <u>www.cambridgema.gov/election</u> and will be available at the Election Commission Office.
