## **2025 Municipal Election Calendar**

**July 1**: Municipal Election Nomination Papers available at Election Commission office.

<u>July 31</u>: 5 p.m. deadline to submit nomination papers & statements of financial interest for candidates.

**August 14**: **5 p.m.** deadline for Election Commission to certify signatures on nomination papers.

August 18: 5 p.m. deadline for municipal candidates to file withdrawal of nomination.

October 25: Last day to register to vote in municipal election. In person registration hours at the Election

Commission office are 9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. Online registration must be completed by 11:59 p.m.

Mail-in registration must be postmarked by October 25th.

October 25: In person early voting period begins. Locations and hours will be posted at the Election

Commission office and online at www.cambridgema.gov/election.

October 27: Deadline for School Committee candidates and Political Committees to file Municipal

Campaign & Political Finance Reports. (City Council candidates should consult their OCPF

packets regarding depository-filing requirements).

October 28: 5 p.m. deadline to request a ballot by mail.

October 31: In person early voting period ends. Locations and hours will be posted at the Election

Commission office and online at www.cambridgema.gov/election.

**November 3**: **Noontime (12 p.m.)** deadline to apply for absentee ballot for over-the-counter voting.

November 4: Municipal Election. Polls are open 7 a.m. until 8 p.m.

All vote-by-mail ballots (except overseas absentee ballots) must arrive at the Election Commission office by 8 p.m. to be counted. Ballot count begins at Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue, Central Square after the polls close. Overseas absentee ballots are

due by **5 p.m.** on Friday, November 14th, but must be postmarked by November 4th.

November 5: 9 a.m. Ballot count resumes at Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue, Central Square.

November 14: Overseas absentee ballots and provisional ballots will be counted at 5 p.m.
