GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE PRINT

Please verify and/or complete all information listed on this form, then sign and date it. Make corrections as necessary. If you would like to use the census form to change your name, Cambridge address or political affiliation, we will need an original signature from each registered voter in the household making a change.

RESIDENT ADDRESS – If your resident address is incorrect, make the change in the space below the incorrect address.

CHANGES – Make all changes on the shaded line below the printed line. Registered voters must each sign the form to make changes to name, address, or political party.

DELETIONS – Put a line through the name of any resident no longer residing at this address and list their new address. Registered voters must sign the form in order to be removed from the voting list.

PARTY – Indicates whether a person is a registered voter. Returning your census keeps your voter status active. “D” = Democrat, “R” = Republican, “U” = Unenrolled (formerly Independent). Other letters refer to political designations.

NAMES OF ALL FAMILY / HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS AT THIS ADDRESS – Includes any member of the family in Military Service, away at school or confined to a rest home. If a NEW member has been added to the family or household, enter the name & information in the space provided on the form.

MAIL TO – This is the designated individual to whom this form has been sent. If you wish to change your designated “MAIL TO” contact, please place a “Y” next to the name of the selected individual. ONLY ONE “MAIL TO” contact may be designated.

DATE OF BIRTH – MM=Month, DD=Day, YYYY=Year. If your date of birth is blank or incorrect, please make appropriate changes.

OCCUPATION – Enter or verify your occupation, not your place of employment.

NATIONALITY – If you are NOT a U. S. Citizen, please indicate/verify your nationality.

VETERAN – A “Y” indicates you are a veteran of the U. S. Armed Forces.
