Note: Italicized figures in precincts 9-1 and 11-3 signify that the figures were derived from the *tallying* computer program rather than the *recording* computer program, which is the source of the figures for the other 31 precincts. Because of an operational error, approximately 20 ballots from precinct 11-3 were counted with the ballots of precinct 9-1. There is thus a discrepancy between the number of voters recorded as having voted at the precinct (not shown here) and the number of ballots counted for the precinct (shown above). The *sums* of the two precincts' voters and ballots are consistent, but the actual distribution of number 1 votes by precinct is slightly overstated for precinct 9-1 and understated for precinct 11-3.
