Subject: New 2 ½” Nozzle

Details:

The department has acquired new 2 ½” combination nozzles. The nozzle is the Task Force Tips Metro 2 (pictured right) and flows **250 GPM at 75 psi** nozzle pressure. This nozzle will be deployed on all engine companies and will be located on **the 2 ½” crosslay** department wide. 2 spare nozzles will be placed on engine 10 & 11.



While smooth bore nozzles have become our “go-to” nozzle for interior fire attack, combination nozzles remain an important tool in our toolbox. The placement of a combination nozzle on the crosslay facilitates operational flexibility.

At incidents where tactics like vapor control, vapor suppression and exposure protection are required a **fog pattern** should be used.

A **straight stream** should be used for interior or transitional fire-attack.

All members should drill with the nozzle on the next working shift.
