- It adds to the plumbing regulations: "The examiners shall promulgate or amend regulations to allow gender-neutral toilet and bathing facilities, including toilet and bathing facilities that contain more than 1 toilet, urinal, or shower separated by privacy walls or partitions, with separate or grouped handwashing fixtures, to be designated or installed in any use group defined in the state building code, regardless of whether the work being performed is new construction or repair, renovation or alteration work."
 - Does the Commission want to draft a letter of support and/or create a working group to tackle this issue and generate support for the bill?
