## **Collection Description:**

In 1881 John H. Corcoran founded Corcoran's in the Hyde Building at 579-587 Massachusetts Avenue in Central Square, Cambridge, Massachusetts, and sold dry goods such as buttons, ribbons, collars, etc. John H. Corcoran died in 1924, and his sons Paul and John took over the business. In 1941 the store moved to a new building at the corner of Essex Street and Massachusetts Avenue. Corcoran's had 23 departments, including cosmetics, home furnishings, lingerie, children's, men's, and women's clothing, etc. Another store was opened in Harvard square in 1949. After Paul Corcoran died in 1974, his son, Paul Jr., sold the building in Central Square and signed a ten year lease with the new owners. When the lease was up for renewal in 1984, the Central Square store closed, and in 1987 the Harvard Square store closed as well, ending Corcoran's 106-year presence in Cambridge.

This collection consists of one flat box of materials relating to Corcoran's. The collection documents the history and development of a long and successful family-run department store that was an important part of the Cambridge community.
