Collection Description:

This collection contains photographic negatives taken by Carleton W. Patriquin. There are approximately 186 black and white negatives, and 207 color negatives. Images include aerial views of Cambridge Redevelopment Authority (CRS) development projects in Kendall Square, as well as views of East Cambridge, Harvard Square, Mount Auburn Hospital, Northwest Cambridge, and the Alewife area. Subjects and specific buildings include the Middlesex County Courthouse, Portland Street freight yards, Longfellow Bridge, Tech Square, 1010 Memorial Drive, and Bethlehem Steel.

Historical Note:

This section is taken in part from Carleton Patriquin's obituary published in the Boston Globe in 1993. Carleton Woodend Patriquin was born on September 2, 1920 in Arlington, Massachusetts. Patriquin graduated from Bryant & Stratton Business School in Boston in 1940, and two years later enlisted in the U.S. Army. While in the service, Patriquin was a Signal Corps photographer. After the war, Patriquin continued his career as an aerial photographer and freelancer working for such agencies as the Boston Herald Traveler and the Portland Press Herald. Patriquin's most influential work was in pioneering the testing of the Polaroid camera and color film processing. He later moved to Maine where he opened a small restaurant and continued his freelance work. Carleton Patriquin died on April 27, 1993.
