The following are matters which the Chair reasonably anticipates the Board will discuss without taking, soliciting or accepting any public testimony.

- 1. Whether the Board of License Commissioners will adopt a temporary emergency policy due to COVID-19 on the issuance of one day alcohol licenses to existing alcohol licensees in order to allow them to open for a maximum of 30 days in a location which is not the currently licensed premises or contiguous thereto (i.e. a pop-up location). Also discuss the one-day alcohol license fee, if temporary emergency order is implemented.
- 2. Application # 78772 Will Gilson, on behalf of Cambridge Cuisine, LLC d/b/a Puritan & Company, has applied for a total of 30 One Day Wine and Malt Licenses to be exercised at Picnic Grove across from 222 Jacobs Street on July 9-12,16-19, 23-26, 30-31, and August 1-2, 6-9, 13-16, 20-23, 27-28 Thursdays and Fridays 4:00 p.m. 8:00 p.m., and Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 p.m. 8:00 p.m. for dinner service. Maximum number of people allowed in the space at one time is 85.
