L. c. c. 93A, c. 138, §§ 23 and 64, c. 140, 204 C.M.R. 2.01(8), and the Board's Rules 2.3, 2.5, 5.1, and 14. Licensee ordered to create a document explaining how the kitchen appreciation fee, taxes and suggested tips are calculated. This document is to be posted conspicuously on the premises, or in the alternative it must be provided to each customer when the bill is provided to them.
