 New Petition (60359) <u>Cambridge Department of Public Works, 147 Hampshire Street, Cambridge,</u> <u>MA 02139</u>, for the following: Bishop Allen Drive - 1) Install electrical and telecommunications conduits in Bishop Allen Drive (Douglass-Columbia block) and Massachusetts Avenue (Douglass-Sidney block) to support Cambridge DPW Parking Lot 6 Storage Tank Project. Construction to be performed by DPW Contractor Skanska and their subcontractor(s). Note that Bishop Allen Drive conduits are being located in the street right-of-way in order to not preclude future housing or other development of Parking Lot 6. Conduit will be installed during various phases of the work between current date and May 2020.
