5. **New petition (1200054) - Comcast**, 426 E. First Street, Boston, MA 02127, for the following: Camp Street - On the northwest side of Camp Street, +/- 148 feet from Fair Oaks Street, mount (1) new 36.8"x24.3"x16" Comcast power supply unit to utility pole #4 to enhance existing Comcast equipment. This is essential to the Comcast network to avoid customer outages and maintain a fluid network as it expands throughout Cambridge.
