POLE AND CONDUIT COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA Thursday, July 28, 2022 at 10:00 A.M. By Remote Participation Via Zoom

This meeting was held remotely in accordance with Chapter 107 of the Acts of 2022 signed into law on July 16, 2022.

Commission Members: Mark Melo (present), and Terrence James Shea (present), Chair Nicole Murati Ferrer (not present).

License Commission Staff Present: Dana Clarke, Administrative Assistant.

Advisor: Stephen Lenkauskas, Retired City Electrician.

Documents considered by the Board: As to all petitions, the Commission considered the application submitted to it and all documents attached thereto.

Decisions: All votes, unless otherwise stated, were taken by roll call vote and were 2-0. When matters are granted with "typical conditions," those are:

- (1) Must obtain Electrical Department Utility Permit and Department of Public Works ("DPW") Permits and comply with the provisions therein.
- (2) Must pay sidewalk preservation off-set fee.
- (3) Must coordinate site visit with DPW.
- (4) Must commence work within sixty (60) days of the grant and complete within six (6) months of the date of the approval.
- (5) Must comply with any amendment City agencies make to the issued permits after the Acceptance Without Reservations is filed.
- 1. New Petition (185177) <u>Traffic, Parking and Transportation, 344 Broadway, Cambridge, MA 02139</u>, for the following: First Street Install new traffic signal at the intersection of First Street and Thorndike Street and remove the existing signal equipment. Work includes conduit installation for the signal cables, handholes, 1 mast arm, 6 pedestal posts and a new controller cabinet. The existing electric service will be maintained. WCRs and sidewalks impacted by our construction activity will also be reconstructed. [Time Stamp: 1:45]

Present: Dan DeRoche (Vanasse & Associates), Heather Hoffman, resident

Summary: This work is to replace the existing traffic signal at First Street and Thorndike Street with new equipment, and update wheelchair ramps. This is a 3-way intersection. Work will consist of replacing the controller cabinet currently at the southwest corner, maintaining the electric service that's in place. Electrical Department is interested in getting conduit out of the Verizon manhole to existing fire alarm pedestal to service fire alarm circuits in the area and for future use. DPW would like existing

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conduit to be used (if viable) and coordination with the Best Buy and Sears building construction that's going on. Heather Hoffman (resident) expressed concerns with pedestrians getting across the street.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions and City conduit.

2. New Petition (183385) Comcast, 426 E. First Street, Boston, MA 02127, for the following: Binney Street - Installation of approximately 290 linear feet of (6) 4" telecom conduits to facilitate the construction of the building at 290 Binney Street. Comcast offered to be the lead company for the common trench at the June 16, 2022, hearing for VP#179630. [Time Stamp: 27:31]; Recall [Time Stamp: 27:31]

Present: Anthony Vatalaro and Bill Conway.

Summary: This work is reconstruction of a new garage. Comcast will be relocating the conduit that's currently running through the park to make way for the new construction. They will be relocating the existing cables that are in that duct bank currently. Electrical Department requests one spare 4-inch conduit for the City. The initial vote was granted with typical conditions and one spare conduit for the City. However, the petition was recalled. The original conduit duct bank is on private property. When it extends out to public right-of-way, whoever is participating needs to petition to be on the public right-of-way. All participants need to file a petition to join the common trench.

Decision: Continued for further coordination and common trench.

3. New Petition (183432) Comcast, 426 E. First Street, Boston, MA 02127, for the following: Pearl Street - Starting at utility pole #538/28 on Pearl Street, trench easterly 4' to the private property line of **146 - 148 Pearl Street**, installing (1) 2" PVC conduit. All work will be completed by the property owner. This petition goes with Eversource petition #177890 that was continued at the June 16, 2022, hearing. [Time Stamp: **30:42**]

Present: Anthony Vatalaro and Bill Conway.

Summary: This work is for the homeowner. Going from aerial to underground service. Permanent sidewalk repair required.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions and permanent sidewalk repair.

4. New Petition (183435) Comcast, 426 E. First Street, Boston, MA 02127, for the following: Webster Avenue - Starting at utility pole #717/6 on Webster Avenue, trench easterly 47' to the private property line of 39-45 Webster Avenue, installing (1) 4" PVC conduit. [Time Stamp: 35:47]

Present: Anthony Vatalaro, Bill Conway, and Sam Azam (Developer).

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Summary: This is pole is going to be replaced. No new attachment will be made on the new pole until the double pole is removed. Verizon will reset the pole and Eversource will do the transfer and then Comcast can attach to the new pole. Permanent trench and sidewalk repair required.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions and permanent trench and sidewalk repair.

5. New Petition (184349) Comcast, 426 E. First Street, Boston, MA 02127, for the following: Harvard Street - Starting at the existing Comcast manhole on Ware Street, trench southerly 79' then turning westerly 25' then turning southerly 12' to the private property line of 396 Harvard Street, installing (1) 4" PVC conduit. This will include the removal and replacement of the brick sidewalk. This is a forced relocation. [Time Stamp: 42:30]

Present: Anthony Vatalaro and Bill Conway.

Summary: Currently being serviced from the neighboring property which is under construction. So the only service Comcast has in the area is underground coming from Ware Street. The trench is coming off Ware across Harvard Street to the building. Cambridge Network Solutions has replied to the common trench.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions.

6. New Petition (184792) Comcast, 426 E. First Street, Boston, MA 02127, for the following: Pleasant Street - Starting at utility pole #550/23 on Pleasant Street, trench northeasterly 79' to the private property line of 46 Pleasant Street, installing (1) 2" PVC conduit. All work will be completed by the property owner/contractor. [Time Stamp: 44:19]

Present: Anthony Vatalaro and Bill Conway.

Summary: This building is being renovated and the property owner wants to go from aerial to underground. To avoid crossing anyone's property, it needs to come from this pole at the corner of Pleasant Place. This whole section will be under construction as part of the River Street Project. There is an existing pole on the right side of the property that can go aerial to aerial and short trench from this pole. Comcast will submit a new design.

Decision: Continued. Comcast will submit new design showing aerial to aerial.

7. New Petition (184398) <u>Crown Castle NG East, 1800 West Park Drive, Marlborough, MA 01581</u>, for the following: Main Street - Starting at existing Crown Castle handhole on Albany Street, trench and install (2) 4" PVC communication conduits 30' +/- northeasterly to the property line of 600 Main Street. Present: Mark Vegnani and Bill Conway

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Summary: Provide fiber optic cable service to new hospital at 600 Mian Street. Electrical would like Crown to use hand hole on the street and make sure it's road ready. Usually 3 X 3 hand hole. Mark Vegnani believes it's a 1 x 2 hand hole and road ready. He will check it out and confirm.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions.

Per the Commission and Verizon not allowed to use this pole. CNS will submit a new design trenching further down the street.

Decision: Continued to allow CNS to submit new drawing/design.

Continuation from August 19, 2021, to obtain license agreements and to submit a complete path/route. (135784) <u>Cambridge Network Solutions, 35 McGrath Highway, Somerville, MA 02143,</u> for the following: Vassar Street - Place aerial fiber optic cable from P85 to P690/73 on Vassar Street. Summary: CNS has gone through utility licensing process. Licenses have been uploaded. Design shows attaching to Pole 73. The correct design starts at Pole 85 (620 Memorial Drive side) to Pole 77(NT). CNS will remove 73 & 75 from the drawing/design.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions and Pole 73 & 75 removed from drawing/design.

10. Continuation from October 21, 2021, to allow petitioner to obtain license agreements. Summary: Clean up issue. License applications have been uploaded. CNS is looking to gain approval for the make ready process.

Decision: Granted.

Summary: CNS was asked to go to Verizon to see if any conduit was available. Went through the make ready process and their request to go from 620 Memorial Drive to the last serving riser pole was denied. CNS uploaded the denial for no capacity to the portal. Pole already has (6) 4-inches around it; more than the City allows. CNS is now asking the ability to trench request to be approved. Electrical would like this to go aerial to aerial. CNS would like to continue this to talk to the property owner.

Decision: Continued to allow CNS to talk to property owner and to submit new drawing/design.

13. New Petition (185282) <u>Cambridge Network Solutions, 35 McGrath Highway, Somerville, MA</u>

<u>02143,</u> for the following: Thorndike Street - Install (1) 2" Communications Conduit Schedule 40 for 103' from 43 Thorndike Street to P. 625/1 through the brick sidewalk and Second Street. [Time Stamp: 1:03:38]

Present: Jeff Harrington

Summary: CNS is looking to run a small-sized conduit (2-inch) from the pole in front of 43 Thorndike Street that sits on Second Street, following existing Comcast pipe core into the side of the building and then route the fiber that way to connect to the customer. Current provider is Comcast; there is some request to be diverse from Comcast. Good mediation to downsize the size of the pipe and try to get off the public right-of-way, as soon as possible. Keep the feed underground and tie info the existing service that they have. The Commission would like to see a short dig from the wooden pole and then rise up and then right into the private property at 43 Thorndike Street Private property route is less digging.

Decision: Granted with Typical Conditions and new drawing/design.

Summary: This petition is awaiting a decision from the Law Department on a waiver. Crown Castle has proposed to relocate the previously approved cabinet size (36 X 18) to this location. And add the (3) panel antenna array to this equipment. They will continue to seek the waiver request from the Law Department, as well.

Decision: Continued further review.

15. New Petition (184670) Crown Castle NG East, 1800 West Park Drive, Marlborough, MA 01581, for the following: Sidney Street - The proposed physical dimensions of the proposed upgrades would be keeping the 48"h x 8.16" diameter antenna and adding a (3) panel antenna array of 19.4" h x 9.6" w x 6.9" d antennas. Summary: This petition is awaiting a decision from the Law Department on a waiver request.

New Petition (185603) Crown Castle NG East, 1800 West Park Drive, Marlborough, MA 01581, for the following: Main Street - Crown Castle is seeking that the requirement on a 6 foot distance (V.C.5) from the installation from the building to be waived and that the size restriction of a 36"x18"x12" equipment cabinet (VII.B) be waived. Currently the pole is 82" from the building. With the proposed equipment cabinet of a depth of 21.5" the installation would be 60.5" or 5 feet from the building. Crown is requesting a waiver on these two requirements as a larger cabinet is needed to support the equipment and future colocation efforts within the City. Please see attached EME report which shows that the exposure to the building is within FCC limits. Aesthetically the antennas and equipment would be above the window lines of the adjacent building so there would be no impact to views outside. [Time Stamp: 1:21:55]

Present: Bryn Thornburgh

Summary: This is a request to keep the existing equipment cabinet on this site. The proposed upgrades would be on the addition of a panel antenna with 2 antennas as part of that array. Currently the existing cabinet is 70 X 23 X 22 which is technically no in compliance with the City but Crown Castle is requesting to keep it since it is already existing on the pole. Equipment was installed prior to the Small Cell Policy. Installed in 2008. The proposed work will consist of 15-foot dig from existing Crown Caste manhole (on the NW side of Landsdowne Street at the intersection of Mass Ave) and the then installing a 24 X 16 hand hole on the concrete sidewalk a few feet adjacent to existing small cell location. Where they will use additional fiber at hand hole. Verizon will meet Crown Castle to that 15-foot dig and feed into that node as well.
