



Kendall Culvert Inflow and Infiltration

Drainage work to begin week of November 8, 2021

Adjustments to pedestrians, bicyclists and vehicle routing at Broadway, Ames Street and the Loughrey Walkway and Bike Path

Dear Kendall Square Neighbor:

Upgrades to the City of Cambridge's drainage infrastructure are being performed on Broadway as part of the Kendall Culvert Inflow and Infiltration project. Approximately 750 linear feet of precast concrete box culvert are to be installed, terminating at Ames Street and Loughrey Walkway with 6.5 foot by 4.5 foot culvert, a precast vault and cast-in-place concrete collar.

The activities in this area will require adjustments to the travel paths on Loughrey Walkway. The walkway will be closed to bicycle traffic with travelers needing to use Galileo Galilei Way as a detour route. Pedestrian travel will remain on the walkway, but will be diverted onto a connector walk to the west as travelers near Broadway. This connector walk will provide access to a sidewalk along the service road at 105 Broadway. At 105 Broadway pedestrians can use the temporary, signaled, mid-block crossing that has been constructed to cross the street.

In addition to the adjustments on Loughrey Walkway, construction activities will cause for the closing of the western crosswalk at Broadway and Ames Street and restrict vehicles travelling westbound on Broadway from turning left onto Ames Street. Westbound vehicles looking to access Ames Street should use Galileo Galilei Way to Main Street to Ames Street.

A vehicle, pedestrian and bicyclist detour and notification signage plan will be implemented to aid in navigating the affected areas. The activities and the impacts described herein are expected to conclude by May 27, 2022, prior to Memorial Day weekend.
