ANNOUNCEMENTS

DROUGHT STATUS	 The City of Cambridge is currently in a Level 1 Drought. The following restrictions apply to all contractors and residents: All nonessential outdoor water uses are limited to no more than one day per week, and only before 9:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m. Watering of ornamentals and flower gardens is allowed using drip irrigation, hand-held hoses, or watering cans. Definition of Nonessential Outdoor Water Use "Nonessential Outdoor Water Use" refers to any water use not required for the following purposes: (a) Health or safety reasons, including operation of public facilities used for cooling (such as splash pads and swimming pools), or washing of boats, engines, or marine equipment to prevent saltwater damage or the spread of invasive species. (b) By permit, license, statute, or regulation. (c) Production of food or fiber, including vegetable gardens. (d) Maintenance of livestock.
	 (e) Core business functions, such as: 1. Plant nurseries – watering as needed to maintain stock. 2. Golf courses – watering greens and tees, and limited fairway watering per 310 CMR 36.07(2)(c)2.ac. 3. Wedding or event venues – watering gardens or ornamentals by hand-held hose or drip
	irrigation as needed. 4. Professional washing of building exteriors, parking lots, driveways, and sidewalks when necessary for construction or renovation (e.g., applying paint, preservatives, pavement, or cement).
	 (f) Irrigation of public parks before 9:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m. (g) Irrigation of public and private recreation fields (including schools and athletic associations) before 9:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m. (h) Irrigation of publicly funded shade trees and trees in the public right-of-way.
