


# Maple Avenue First Community Meeting October 20, 2021 Cambridge Street to Broadway Reconstruction Project

# Traffic Calming

Narrow the road
 Add Parking
 Pavement Markings (edge line for bikes)
 Visual Narrowing by Adding Trees

- Horizontal Devices: make the road less straight Chicanes
   Crossing Islands
- Vertical devices: make vehicles go over something Raised intersections & crosswalks



  - -12/15/2021









### Basic Reconstruction + TC
