Dear Resident or Business,

On *Saturday, October 8,* the City's contractor, C.J. Mabardy, Inc. will perform the asphalt paving leveling course on Concord Ave, from Blanchard Rd to the Alewife Brook Rotary. **Paving operations will take place during the day on Saturday, October 8, from 7 AM to 5 PM**. Final paving will take place in the next few weeks.

During work hours on Saturday (7 AM to 5 PM), vehicle traffic on Concord Ave will be reduced to one lane; outbound traffic (Cambridge to Belmont) will remain open, and inbound traffic (Belmont to Cambridge) will be detoured. Traffic moving inbound will be detoured right onto Blanchard Rd, left onto Grove St, left onto Huron Ave, and left onto Fresh Pond Parkway to Concord Ave. To the extent possible, MBTA buses will be allowed to travel in both directions.

Vehicle access in and out of properties on Concord Ave will be somewhat limited for periods of time (1-2 hours) during paving to allow for the asphalt to cool. Please plan vehicle trips accordingly. All sidewalks will remain open.
