MOUNT AUBURN STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

JFK Street to Holyoke Street Construction begins Monday, April 13

The City's contractor, Newport Construction, will mobilize on Monday, April 13 to begin surface improvements on Mt Auburn St, from JFK St to Holyoke St. Overall construction is anticipated to last about 3 months.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project will reconstruct the existing sidewalks and roadway on Mt Auburn St between JFK St and Holyoke St. Crews will also widen the northern sidewalk (odd side) to enhance the pedestrian experience and facilitate outdoor dining, additional seating, bicycle parking and new street trees. Lighting upgrades are also included in the project.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Crews will mobilize on Mt Auburn St on Monday, April 13.
- Overall construction activities will take about 3 months to complete.
- Crews will first perform drainage upgrades, and roadway and sidewalk reconstruction on the northern (odd) side of Mt Auburn St. Once this section is complete, crews will shift to the southern (even) side.
- We will continue to provide updates as the construction progresses.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Mt Auburn St will remain open with a single lane of traffic throughout construction.
- Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
