The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) is completing the final design of improvements for the Harvard Station Busway to enhance the level of service, performance, and passenger safety.

Located within Harvard Station, the busway connects 10 bus routes serving Cambridge and the surrounding communities with the MBTA Red Line. The busway is the third busiest bus stop on the MBTA, and averages 16,000 passengers per weekday.

The MBTA will hold public information sessions to provide an opportunity for the public to learn more about the planned improvements for the busway.



Temporary Bus Service & Stop Changes during Harvard Busway Improvements



BEGINNING JUNE 23

MT. AUBURN STREET

Bus Routes 71 and 73 Both routes will begin and end at Mt. Auburn Street and will not enter the tunnel.

BRATTLE STREET

Routes 72, 74, 75, 72/75, 77, 78, 96 (drop-off only)

Inbound buses from Mass. Avenue and Concord Avenue will drop passengers off on Brattle Street, near Palmer Street. Outbound buses will continue to board passengers in the open tunnel.
