

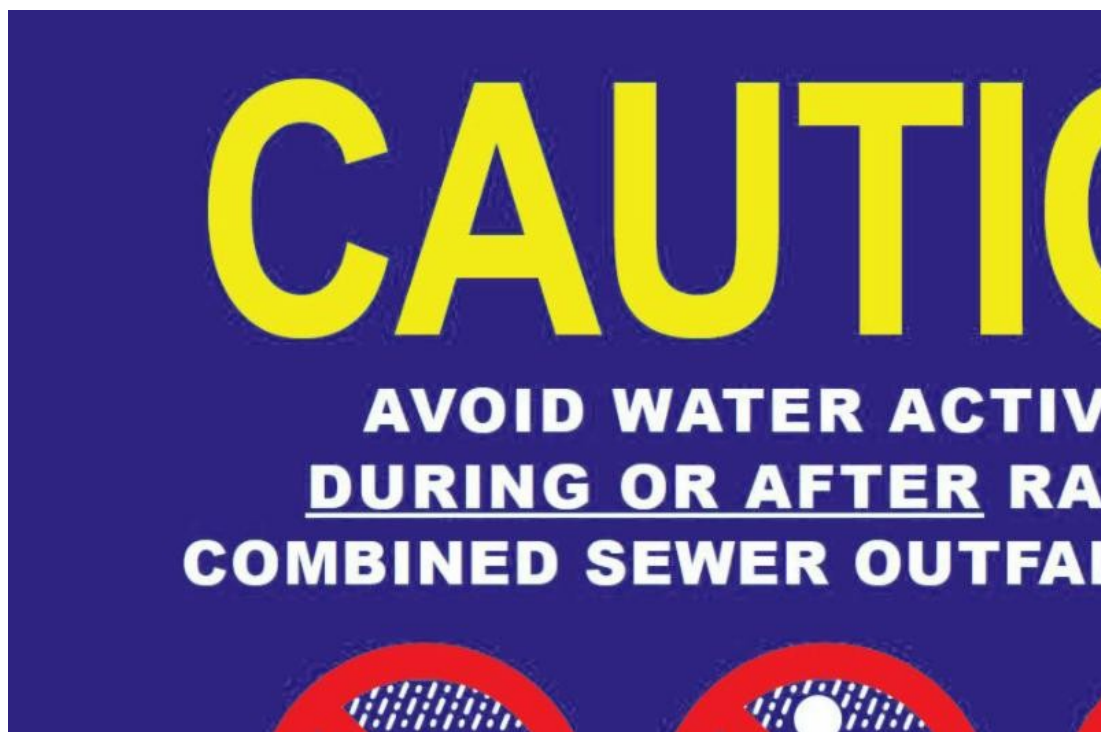

## CSO Alert, City of Cambridge



A Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) occurred in the Little River/Alewife Brook and consisted of untreated sewage and waste.

Location: CAM401A: discharges upstream of the confluence of the Little River and Alewife Brook and upstream of the Route 2 Bridge.

Date: March 6, 2025

Start time: (1) 3:22AM, (2) 3:57AM

End time: (1) 3:26AM, (2) 4:38AM

Duration: Total duration 47 minutes

Estimated volume\*: 0.89 MG

*\*3-year average calculated using data from 2021, 2022 and 2023*

Potentially affected areas: Arlington, Cambridge, Somerville, and Medford

Required public health warning: Avoid contact with these water bodies for 48 hours after the discharge or overflow ceases due to increased health risks from bacteria and other pollutants. See website for more information:
