Must be:

- 18 years of age or older
- employed by a **Massachusetts-based organization or entity** that serves or supports Veterans (e.g., VA, VSO, community organization, or health system)
- able to speak to how gambling impacts Veterans' well-being, engagement with services, or harm reduction
- English-speaking and able to provide informed consent
