

Allowed water usage during drought

- Vegetable gardens, plants for fiber
- Livestock
- Commercial Operations
 - Plant nurseries to maintain stock
 - Golf courses as necessary to maintain greens and tees, and limited fairway
 - Wedding venues or similar special events that limit watering to hand-held hose or drip irrigation as necessary to maintain gardens, flowers and ornamental plants
 - Professional washing of exterior building surfaces, parking lots, driveways
- Irrigation for public parks and recreation fields
- Irrigation of publicly-funded shade trees
- To establish a new lawn as necessary to stabilize soil in response to new construction or following the repair or replacement of a Title 5 system.

Banned water usage during a drought

- Water of turf lawns
- Water of flower gardens
- Private washing of cars
- Filling of pools
- Hose or pressure washing of non exempt driveways, sidewalks, and buildings.
