Why Monarchs? Why Here?

Migratory monarchs have been officially declared "endangered" by the IUCN, and we've lost 80% of the population since 1990. The chief factors of their decline are loss of milkweed, logging activity in Mexico, extensive pesticide use in the US, and extreme weather events. Because Monarchs migrate, we need a national effort. As an official "waystation" Fresh Pond is a wonderful place for adult monarchs and for their young to grow up!
