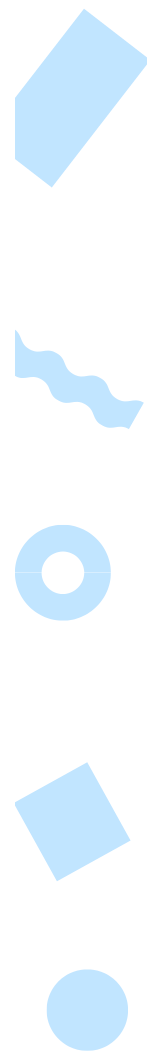


Photo Share:

Rock Paper Scissors Tournament:

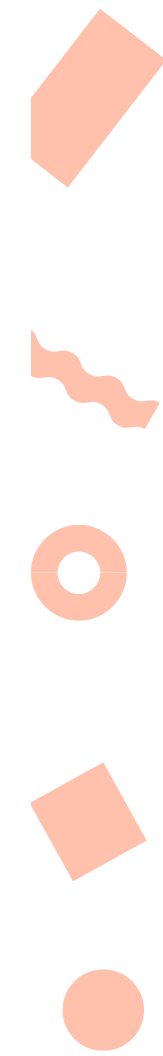
Players pair up and play rock paper scissors. Winners move on and play each other until only one player remains.

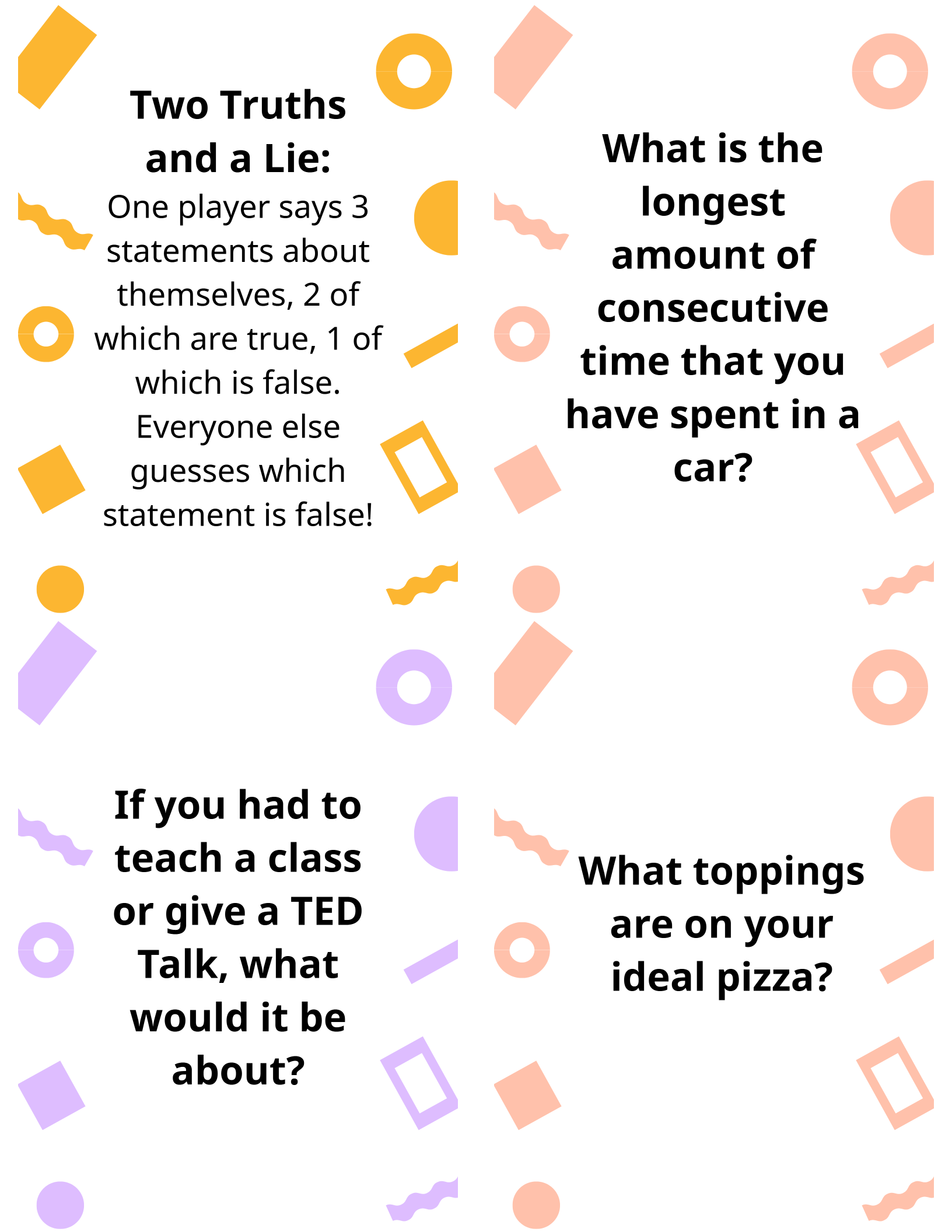

Two Truths and a Lie:

One player says 3 statements about themselves, 2 of which are true, 1 of which is false. Everyone else guesses which statement is false!

What is the longest amount of consecutive time that you have spent in a car?

If you had to teach a class or give a TED Talk, what would it be about?

What toppings are on your ideal pizza?



What was the best thing that happened to you this past week?

If you were stranded on a deserted island, what three items would you want to have with you?

Common Threads:

Players get into pairs or small groups and have a set amount of time (such as 3 minutes) to find as many things as they can that they have in common.

If you could travel anywhere in the world right now, where would you go?

This or That:

Someone asks the group a this or that question (such as cats or dogs).

Players move to the side of the room that matches their answer (left side = cats, right side = dogs).

What is the last show or book that you binged and loved?

What is your motto in life?

What is the best piece of advice you have ever received?
