



WORKING GROUP MEETING: TUESDAY APRIL 30, 2019


The Grand Junction Multi-use Path is a proposed multi-use path for people walking, biking, or recreating next to the existing tracks in the Grand Junction corridor from the Boston University Bridge to the Cambridge-Somerville municipal line in East Cambridge.

The Grand Junction Multi-Use Path Working Group will meet about once a month through 2019. Meetings are open to the public.

At this meeting, City and design team staff will get to know the Working Group members, provide an overview of the overall project, its relation to City policies and plans, and discuss the project timeline.
