RE: Zoning Ordinance Section 6.104.2 b "Short-Term Bicycle Parking

Public Contribution" pricing backup

Following is the breakdown for how the current price per rack was developed. The prices are estimated for what it would cost a property owner to install a standard galvanized "post-and-ring" (DERO "hitch" or equivalent) bicycle parking rack into concrete in accordance with zoning standards. By contributing to this fund, the city takes responsibility for siting, installation, ownership, and maintenance this bicycle parking. In addition, the city will be responsible for replacement, if needed, so additional cost is factored in. This memorandum will be periodically updated to reflect changes in costs.
