

1. **New Petition (VP 48940) Cambridge Network Solutions LLC, 35 McGrath Highway, Somerville, MA 02143**, for the following: **Pacific Street** - Starting at Eversource MH#1228 on **Pacific Street**, install 1,105'+/- of fiber optic cable in a southerly direction, continuing 1,340' +/- easterly on **Albany Street**, and continuing 92'+/- southerly to Eversource MH#3498. There is no excavation in the above manholes. Starting at Eversource MH#3498 on **Massachusetts Avenue** trench and install (1) 4" conduit easterly 15'+/- to Level 3 MH#0515-2604, and place (1) 3'x3' CNS manhole in between.

2. **New Petition (VP 48942) Cambridge Network Solutions LLC, 35 McGrath Highway, Somerville, MA 02143**, for the following: **Pacific Street** - Starting at utility pole #nt/nt on **Pacific Street**, install 139'+/- of fiber optic cable northwesterly, continuing 301'+/- southwesterly on **Brookline Street**, continuing 521'+/- easterly on **Tudor Street**, continuing 713'+/- southerly on **Sidney Street**, and continuing 273'+/- easterly on **Erie Street** to utility pole #240/6.

3. **New Petition (VP 49197) Cambridge Network Solutions LLC, 35 McGrath Highway, Somerville, MA 02143**, for the following: **Main Street at Broadway** - Trench and install 325'+/- of (2) 4' communication conduits easterly from existing private property conduit in the sidewalk at **100 Main Street** to the existing Level 3 MH#0515-1302 on **Main Street**.

4. **Continuation from May 16, 2019, to provide petitioner time to obtain 8M Permit (VP 45924) Level 3 Communications/Century Link, 300 Bent Street, Cambridge, MA 02141**, for the following: **Education Circle at North Street** - Continuation from petition 33891 - starting at existing Level 3 MH on **Education Circle at Museum Way** trench and install (1) 4" conduit 370'+/- southeasterly to proposed 3'x3' level 3 MH. From proposed level 3 MH continue 230' northeasterly on **Education Street** to existing private telecomm mh.

5. **New Petition (VP 47740)** Crown Castle Fiber, 80 Central Street, Boxborough, MA 01719, for the following: **Bent Street and Fifth Street** - Proposed 78' of (1)-4" SCH 40 PVC for fiber from existing Level 3 MH#19 to proposed 33" x 33" handhole. Proposed 85' of (1)-4" SCH 40 PVC for fiber from proposed handhole to joint Pole #37.

6. **New Petition (VP 48565)** Verizon New England Inc, 385 Myles Standish Boulevard, Taunton, MA 02780, for the following: **Third Street** - Place one 4" lateral conduit approximately 30' easterly to connect to **#350 Third Street**. Main conduit line is on the easterly side of **Third Street**.

7. **Continuation from April 25, 2019, to provide time to discuss with DPW – route and alternate routes. (VP 43722)** TC Systems, Inc., 157 Green Street, Suite 2, Foxboro, MA 02035, for the following: **Massachusetts Avenue and Temple Street** - Proposed break out at Existing VZ Manhole #26/99, thence 266+/- ft along **Massachusetts Avenue** to a proposed 3'X3' TC Systems Manhole, thence approx. 124' NE/LY across **Massachusetts Avenue**, and a distance down **Temple Street** to a proposed 5" core at **727 Massachusetts Avenue**. TC Systems is proposing (1) 4" conduit, and (1) 4" City shadow conduit, together, both approximately 390' in the same trench.

8. **New Petition (VP 48693)** Nstar Electric Company, 10 Linwood Street, Somerville, MA 02143, for the following: **Binney Street** - Westerly from MHC3060, approximately 162 feet west of **Fifth Street**, to install approximately 100 feet--conduit.

9. **New Petition (VP 48963)** Nstar Electric Company, 10 Linwood Street, Somerville, MA 02143, for the following: **Hancock Street** - Westerly from pole 327/3, near the intersection of **Kinnaird Street**, to install approximately 41 feet--conduit.

10. **New Petition (VP 48694)** Nstar Electric Company, 10 Linwood Street, Somerville, MA 02143, for the following: **Brookford Street** - Southwesterly from pole 101/7, approximately 404 feet south of **Massachusetts Avenue**, to install approximately 7 feet-conduit.

11. **New Petition (VP 48697)** Nstar Electric Company, 10 Linwood Street, Somerville, MA 02143, for the following: **Water Street** - Northeasterly from **Monsignor Obrien Highway**, continuing through MHC3664, to MBTA property line, to install approximately 100-foot conduit.

**12. New Petition (VP 48700) Nstar Electric Company, 10 Linwood Street, Somerville, MA 02143**, for the following: **Jackson Street** - Northwesterly from pole 394/4, approximately 110 feet north of **Rindge Avenue**, to install approximately 8 feet-conduit.
