Program Information and Policies

The Spring Session classes will begin Monday, February 24, 2020 and end Friday, June 12, 2020.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- Complete a **Class Selection Form** with the <u>1st and 2nd class choices indicated</u>.
- If not paying in full at time of registration, a deposit of ¼ of the total tuition plus the \$25 registration fee must be left and the remainder will be billed.
- Completed Registrations should be returned to the <u>DROP BOX</u> during registration hours. If a family would like assistance with the forms or has questions, the Director will be available from 5:30-6:30 PM on Tuesday, 1/21/20, Wednesday, 1/22/20, and Thursday, 1/23/20 in the Community School Office.
- Incomplete materials will not be processed until complete (this could affect the registration in the lottery).
- A lottery system will be used to fill classes.
- An emailed invoice will have the classes your child is enrolled in for the Spring Session.
- Children may only register for classes in their appropriate age/school year group.

IMPORTANT:

- Priority registration for Wednesday classes will be given to students registered in the program Monday through Friday.
- All balances must be paid before registration will be processed.
- After registration is complete, students may drop classes but families may not drop entire days.
- Unless medical reasons exist, students absent for two days consecutively in the same class will lose their spot and no refunds will be made.
- You will be notified <u>only if the class you have chosen is full</u>. If you do not hear from us, you may assume your child is enrolled in the selected class.
- Students who took a music lesson in the first session of the 2019-2020 academic year will receive
 right of first refusal and will be grandfathered into their lesson time for the spring session. We
 will place new students from the wait list in lesson slots as they become available. Please request
 lessons via the Class Selection Form.
- Please place sibling registration materials in the same envelope.

Registration will continue upon availability after the dates above.

Completed Forms are to be submitted in an envelope in the DROP BOX, located outside the Community School Office during registration hours.

PAYMENTS:

If not paying in full at time of registration, a deposit of ¼ of the total tuition plus the \$25 registration fee must be left and the remainder will be billed. If necessary, a payment plan can be arranged with the director. Checks or Money Orders (NO CASH) should be made payable to: **King Community School.** If you have an outstanding balance with any Department of Human Service Program as of January 17, 2020, your child's registration will not be accepted until all payments are made. Class fees are based on the number of weeks a class meets. **Returned checks** will be charged an additional \$25.00. Full payment must be made within 48 hours of the first class to avoid disruption in your child's schedule.

CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

If a class is not fully enrolled, the class may be cancelled. You will be notified and given a refund, or an alternative class may be chosen. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. A full refund will be given if we are notified within 24 hours after the first class. Partial refunds will only be given if a child is no longer able to participate due to medical reasons. Refunds are not issued for missed classes.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Partial scholarships are available to <u>children who are Cambridge residents</u> and meet our qualification guidelines. Please request a financial aid form from the director. Income verification in the form of W – 2 or 4 current pay stubs must be submitted with the application. All information provided will be kept confidential. Deadline for financial assistance is **Friday, January 31, 2020.**

EARLY RELEASE DAYS

For the 2019-2020 school year, the Cambridge Public School scheduled all district-wide early release days for Wednesdays. Due to our regular 2pm release time at the ML King School, the King Community School will continue with our regularly scheduled classes on those days. *There will be no special activities planned for district-wide early release days this school year.*

CHILD PICK UP & ABSENCES

Children will only be released to those you have authorized on your child's registration / emergency card. If there is any change in pick up arrangements, the director must be notified in advance. Only children ages 9 & up will be allowed to walk home with parent/guardian permission. Please notify us by phone or email if your child will be absent from the program.

Our program offers enrichment classes. Our staff invest time and effort into preparing their classes for your child's benefit, please avoid disruptions and plan to pick up your child at dismissal times only. If you do need to pick up at a different time, please notify the director in advance.

Our Staff or Program cannot be responsible for any play dates arranged by parents; we can ONLY supervise children enrolled in our program at any given time or day. Please speak with Claire if your child's schedule changes due to arranged play dates.

LATE FEE POLICY

Please respect our staff and pick up children on time. Children must be picked up promptly at the end of class. There will be a late fee of \$1.00 per minute for each minute you are late after the scheduled pick up time. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child's participation in the program. Chronic lateness – You will be asked to withdraw your child from the program and no refund will be given.

PROGRAM CLOSINGS

Classes are not held on city holidays, snow days or on days the Cambridge Public Schools are closed.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

When a child's behavior has been unusually difficult or disruptive, the CS director will communicate with the child's parents/guardian about the incident(s). The goal of this conversation is to solicit their insights into the causes of the behavior. Parents/guardians' cooperation and support is an important part of resolving any behavior problems. If the problem persists, a parent/guardian conference will be scheduled to discuss the problem and formulate an action plan for addressing the problem behavior in the classroom.

In cases where a child's behavior poses a threat to his/her own safety or the safety of others, with the recommendation of the Program Manager and the Division Head, the child may be removed from the group or program for a period of time. Before the child may return to the program, a conference will be held with the Director, Program Manager, parents/guardians, and in some cases, the child, to determine whether it is appropriate for a child to continue in the program. When it is appropriate for a child to continue in the program, an action plan will be created and implemented. In some cases, this action plan may include recommended counseling for the child.

If the standards for safe participation in the program with the existing staff/child ratios cannot be met, the parent/guardian may be asked to withdraw the child from the program. In any case of withdrawal / termination, the DHSP staff will work with the parent/guardian to provide appropriate closure for the child.

If a child has been suspended from the regular school day the child may not attend Community School programming.

Community Schools Bus Policy

The Community School Programs offer afterschool enrichment classes in every elementary school in Cambridge. Most children attend the classes at the Community School located in their school building. Some families prefer to have their children attend classes in the school building located in their neighborhood. If an established bus route exists from a child's school to the preferred Community School, very often the Cambridge Public Schools are able to transport children to that Community School. Parents/guardians need to make transportation arrangements with the Cambridge Public Schools.

In an effort to support families, beginning this year a staff person from Community Schools will be available in front of the school to greet children under the age of 9 arriving by bus and will escort them into the school. Children age 9 and older who have parental permission may enter the school on their own.

To avoid disrupting ongoing classes and to support children's full participation in the enrichment classes, children must arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of Community School Program and no later than 1 hour past the program start time. 


