

2025–2026 DHSP Afterschool Programs Monthly Tuition Rates

- Monthly tuition rates are based on family income, household size, and the number of days a child is enrolled each week. **Payment is due the first week of each month.**
- Tuition is free for 6th–8th graders. Cambridge Youth Programs (CYP) tuition rates apply to 4th and 5th graders.
- Fletcher Maynard Academy (FMA) and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. (MLK) Community Schools have different monthly tuition rates that reflect the fewer number of hours the two programs operate each day.
- **Sibling tuition discount:** Families who pay full tuition for one child enrolled in a DHSP afterschool program will receive a 50% discount on tuition for any siblings enrolled. The discount is not applicable to 6th–8th graders enrolled in CYP's afterschool programs who receive free tuition.
