Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

Do you need help paying winter heating bills? Apply for Heating Help!

We help income-eligible Cambridge and Somerville residents save money on their winter heating bills between November 1 and April 30.

- Renters and homeowners can apply.
- Eligibility is based on your 4-week gross income (see table below).
 Income documentation and proof of how you heat is required.
- If your circumstances have changed, you may be newly eligible.

- If you qualify for HEAP (formerly Fuel Assistance), our staff can connect you to other programs that help you save money and energy.
- No Heat Emergencies: If you do not have heat, you receive a 72 hour shut-off notice, or you have less than 1/8 of a tank of oil, we can help! Call us at 617-665-6234 for same-day assistance.
