Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day Instructions

These will be very busy events. DPW and Cambridge Police staff will be on site to assist with traffic. See image below for map of how to commute to the event.

To make sure we can accommodate all residents, please take into consideration these tips:

1. Please leave items that you do NOT wish to dispose of at home, so they aren't accidentally taken for disposal.
2. We will collect waste ONLY from the trunk of your car or the bed of your pickup truck. If you have items that are too bulky for just the trunk, please notify staff upon arrival.
3. For worker safety and hazardous waste containment, ONLY staff should handle hazardous waste.
4. We will ask you to open your trunk. **Residents and visitors should NOT exit their vehicle for any reason at any point during the event.**
5. Bins, buckets, boxes, etc. will NOT be returned. For example, do not place the bottle of motor oil in a bin you wish to keep. Place the bottle directly in the trunk.
6. If you are walking or biking to the event, there will be a station for you to safely drop-off items. Please ask for assistance from a Cambridge Police officer or Public Works employee before entering the site.
