Construction of Raised Crosswalk on Norfolk St. at Broadway

Thursday, August 8 & Friday, August 9

Dear Neighbor,

In connection with the Broadway Reconstruction Project, the City's Contractor, D'Allessandro Corporation, will be performing the installation of a raised crosswalk on the south side of Broadway (park side) on Norfolk Street at Broadway. This work is expected to take two days to complete and will begin on Thursday, August 8. During this work, Norfolk Street residents will not be able to access the roadway from Broadway from 7am on Thursday, August 8 to 4pm on Friday, August 9. Norfolk Street must be accessed via Harvard Street.

What to expect during construction

- General work hours will be from 7AM to 4PM.
- Norfolk Street residents will be detoured to Harvard Street via Columbia Street or Prospect Street, in order to access Norfolk Street.
- The Norfolk Street entrance from Broadway will be inaccessible on a 24 hour basis.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted in advance of construction. Please be sure to check posted signs for exact date and times.
- Police details will be onsite to help manage traffic.
