- Setting trigger points for possible phase change of transmission management Relevant to CPSD and city What data sets are available (Biobot, MIT, Harvard % positivity, other data sets)?
- Testing of staff and students in schools as means to prevent outbreak Consider surveillance testing that is cheap rapid based on modeling by M. High sensitivity qPCR required to assure negativity (eg prior to return), confirm diagnosis (eg to seek medical attention) or for testing pooled samples or surface swabbing.
