- Youth athletic league proposal is insufficient (eg wrestling?!, details on masks? Travel?)
- How to inspire mask use among sports players in parks?
- Improve messaging about benefit of vaccine-induced herd immunity
- Need plan on how to handle sewage data, supplement with offering testing to non-Cambridge residents who are working in frontline jobs
- SNFs are under excellent control so sewage testing from these catchments is not priority
- Follow up on OST- who is in charge of safety?? Sam will probe this.
- Qs for Michael Mina: how to drive behavior that actually helps prevent spread?!
