


# Middlesex County and Cambridge Cases by Risk Category




#### MA COVID-19 Hospitalizations

#### On Feb. 3, 2022:

- 1,503 MA residents were hospitalized with COVID-19.
- 90% of non-ICU hospital beds and 83% of ICU beds in the region were occupied.

## COVID-19 Vaccination Status of Cambridge Residents by Age

- To protect confidentiality and get resources to more impacted residents, packets will also be delivered to neighbors (e.g., entire floor of a building or entire block).
