Sitting Members: Constantine Alexander, Brendan Sullivan, Andrea A. Hickey, and Jim Monteverde CONSTANTINE ALEXANDER: Welcome to the September 9, 2021 meeting of the Cambridge Board of Zoning Appeals. My name Gus Alexander and I am the Chair.

This meeting is being held remotely, due to statewide emergency orders limiting the size of public gatherings in response to COVID-19, and in accordance with Governor Charles D. Baker's Executive Order of March 12, 2020, temporarily amending certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law; as well as the City of Cambridge temporary emergency restrictions on city public meetings, city events, and city permitted events, due to COVID-19, dated May 27, 2020 .

This meeting is being video and audio recorded, and is broadcast on cable television Channel 22 within Cambridge. In due course, there will a transcript of tonight's proceedings.

All Board members, applicants, and members of the
public will state their name before speaking. All votes will be taken by roll call.

Members of the public will be kept on mute until it is time for public comment. I will give instructions for public comment at that time, and you can also find instructions on the city's webpage for remote BZA meetings. Generally, you will have up to three minutes to speak.

I'll start by asking the Staff to take Board
member attendance and verify that we have -- at least four members of the Board are on the call.

SISIA DAGLIAN: Jim Monteverde? JIM MONTEVERDE: Jim Monteverde is here. SISIA DAGLIAN: Andrea Hickey?

ANDREA HICKEY: Andrea Hickey present.
SISIA DAGLIAN: Laura Wernick?

SISIA DAGLIAN: Oops, Laura's not here. Brendan Sullivan?

BRENDAN SULLIVAN: Brendan Sullivan present and audible.

SISIA DAGLIAN: And Gus?

CONSTANTINE ALEXANDER: Although we're missing one member, we still have four -- at least four, and therefore a quorum. So we're going to proceed. And we only have one case tonight. It's a continued case, and is a case involving 2072 Massachusetts Avenue, Case \#017326.

Anyone on behalf of the petitioner wishes to speak at this point at this point?

JENNIFER SCHULTZ: Yes. Hello, Chairman. My name is Jennifer Schultz, and I am Permitting and Land Use counsel for the petitioner. I'm a partner at the law firm of Sullivan \& Worcester, and I lead our Permitting crew. We submitted a letter of withdrawal for this application on August 27 of this year, so a little over a week and a half ago. And we stand by that withdrawal without any alteration.

We're happy for the letter to be read into the record, if you desire, but we have no further comment in addition to our letter of withdrawal.

CONSTANTINE ALEXANDER: Thank you. We do have, obviously, a copy of your letter, and I'll just refer to the opening sentence of the letter, which says what you just said; that you were writing to formally withdraw the
applicant's comprehensive permit application submitted to this Board on November 10, 2020.

Since you have confirmed that you're still -- that is still the position of your client, the Chair will move that we'll accept the application to withdraw the permit; the application before us.

Brendan, how do you vote?
BRENDAN SULLIVAN: Brendan Sullivan yes to accept the withdrawal.

CONSTANTINE ALEXANDER: Jim?

JIM MONTEVERDE: Jim Monteverde yes to accept the withdrawal.

CONSTANTINE ALEXANDER: Andrea Hickey?
ANDREA HICKEY: Andrea Hickey yes to accepting the withdrawal.
