Notes on Green Sheets:

- Don't rush the process, take the time to do it right. Build off of what currently exists, don't create something entirely new.
- Discreet, specific, measurable goals to make CPS Wellness & Substance Use Policy happen. Get an outside perspective, make sure there is funding, make sure there is youth buy-in and generational scaffolding,
- Falcon block, teachers in charge of it need support in order to be the trusted adults.
- Instead of creating a new network, reaching out to groups that already exist, clubs, peer groups/ mentoring groups like pathfinders and big brothers big sisters as examples. Bridge the knowledge gap so that those who really want to be involved can participate.
- Perseverance, weighing the significance of each item individually. Not just for one person but still adaptable to an individual's needs.
