TRASH DISPOSAL



Trash must be in a **rodent-resistant barrel with tight-fitting lid** when
stored on private property and when set
at the curb for collection
(maximum 50 pounds or 50 gallon)



Don't overfill barrels so that lids don't close tight




Trash in plastic bags may be placed at the curb on the day of collection, not the night before. Only heavy duty bags are accepted - no thin grocery or kitchen bags

Barrels may be placed at the curb

after 6pm the night before collection or by 7am on collection day

Please remove receptacles from the curb by end of the day of collection
