

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


Population Trend: 1980 - 2013



Youth Age by Year: 2000 and 2010





Youths by Census Tract: 2010




Race & Hispanic Origin: 1980 - 2010




Black Youths: 1980 – 2010




Native Born Blacks vs. Total Population: 2010 - 2012







Native Born vs. Immigrant Blacks: 2010 - 2012



Black Household Population by Age by Sex: 2010




Asian Youths: 1980 – 2010



Asian Household Population by Age by Sex: 2010




Asian Household Population by Ethnicity: 2010




Hispanic Youths: 1980 – 2010





Hispanic Household Population by Origin: 2010






Neighborhood Diversity: 2010




Haitian Population: 2009 - 2013

Native and Foreign Born Residents: 2011 - 2013








Household Trends: 1990 – 2010



Household Comparison: 2010




Families with Children Comparison: 2010




Educational Attainment: 2011 - 2013




Educational Attainment of Parents: 2010-2012




Median Income: 2011 - 2013

Households by Percent Median Income: 2000 and 2007-11




What do we mean by “Poverty”?

5 persons	\$27,827


By definition, dormitory and other group quarters residents do not fall under poverty thresholds.

Poverty by Race: 2010-12




Childhood Poverty: 2000 and 2010-12




Family Poverty: 2000 and 2010-12



Families, Race and Poverty: 2000 and 2010-12




Poverty Income Deficit: 2010 - 2012






Proportion of Families w/ Children in Poverty: 2009 - 2013




Citywide Share Families w/ Children in Poverty: 2009 - 2013
