HURLEY PARK RENOVATION UPDATE

Dear Hurley Park Neighbor,

Crews have mobilized to resume renovation activities at Hurley Park. Improvements will be ongoing, weather permitting, throughout the spring and summer.

The renovated park will include:

- Refurbished playground
- Water and sand play area
- Water sprinklers
- Tables and seating with umbrellas
- New community garden (raised beds)
- Improved lighting
- Swing benches
- Fencing improvements
- Reconstructed park pathways and sidewalk on Hurley St
- Emergency phone and message board.

Project Schedule

Last fall, crews completed all the demolition and utility work within the park. In the next few months, crews will install the new play and park equipment, and reconstruct the pathways and sidewalk on Hurley St. Please note that all work is weather dependent. We expect the park to reopen in late summer. We will continue to provide updates as the construction progresses.

What to Expect during Renovations

The park will continue to be closed during the renovations. No Parking signs will be posted along Hurley St; please be sure to check dates and times. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.
