The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in the City Hall Annex, Second Floor, 344 Broadway, Cambridge, Massachusetts on a Zoning Petition by Latoyea H. Cockrill, et al., to amend the Zoning Ordinance by creating a new definition in Article 2.000 for “Short-term rental” to mean the accessory use of all or part of a residential dwelling unit by rental for temporary occupancy for dwelling, sleeping, or lodging; amending Section 4.31.1.1 of the Table of Use Regulations to permit ‘Short-term rental’ use in all Residential Districts; and create a new Section 11.900 – “Short-Term Rental Use” to govern this use.
