### **After School Enrichment, Adult, Senior and Family Program Information**

Fall Enrichment Programs Begin September 19th 2016 to February 17th 2017 from 3:00pm-5:30pm each day, with an option for an extended day pick up time of 6pm for an additional \$12.00 per day needed. **Late pick up fee is \$1.00 per minute** and is due within 5 days of occurrence. During the after school program, students will have a Healthy Snack from 3:00-3:15pm. They will go to their first class from 3:15-4:15pm then they will have a 15 minute break time before being picked up at 4:30 or going into the second class from 4:30-5:30pm.
