FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Partial scholarships are available to families who qualify. Please request a financial aid form from the director. Income verification in the form of 4 current pay stubs must be submitted with the application. All information provided will be kept confidential. Deadline for financial assistance is Thursday February 9, 2018.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Registration for RETURNING STUDENTS begins on Monday, January 22nd, Tuesday January 23rd & Wednesday January 24, 2018 in the Community School Office or Peabody School Cafeteria. Registration for all NEW STUDENTS will begin on Monday February 5, 2018. All programs will be on a first-come, first-served basis. **NOTE: There will be a \$25.00 registration fee per child for the school year.**

Registration will not be held on Monday February 26th (1st day of classes).

PAYMENTS: Full payment is due at the time of registration unless a payment plan is arranged with the director. Checks should be made payable to: **Fitzgerald Community School.**

***Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00. Full payment must be received within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child's program schedule.**

If you have any outstanding balances due with any Department of Human Service Program your child may not register until all payments are up to date.

REFUNDS: If a class does not fill, the class may have to be cancelled. This is a rare occurrence, but if it should happen you will be notified and given a full refund, with the opportunity to enroll in another class. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. Refunds will be given only if we are notified within 24 hours of the first class your child attended. Exceptions for medical issues, documentation required.

SCHOLARSHIP DRIVE: *We welcome your contribution to assist us with providing scholarships to families in financial need. You may choose to support a particular program or contribute to our general scholarship fund. We thank you for all your support. Feel free to add it to your reg. check or separate made payable to: Fitzgerald Community School.* Art supplies, games, sewing supplies and snack donations are always welcome.

EARLY RELEASE DAYS: Regular scheduled classes are not held on early release days. A special activity or field trip will be planned. Watch for flyers the week before, they will be distributed to all students. Class fees are set on the number of times a class actually meets. Therefore early release days and holidays, when there are no scheduled classes, have been taken into account and fees have been set accordingly. Enrollment open to currently enrolled students only.

HOLIDAYS AND SNOW DAYS: Classes are not held on snow days, school holidays or any other days there is no school for the Cambridge Public Schools.

SPRING SESSION: Classes have been scheduled to begin the week of Monday February 26, 2018 And will end the week of Thursday June 14, 2018. (No Classes Friday June 15th (Holiday))

LATE FEE POLICY: All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. A \$1.00 late fee is assessed for a late pick-up for every minute or any fraction thereof starting 5 minutes after the class ends. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours of the week.

Excessive late pick-up or failure to pay late fees may result in suspension of services.

EQUAL ACCESS: The City of Cambridge, Fitzgerald Neighborhood Council, does not discriminate in providing services on the basis of race, religion, national origin, cultural heritage, political beliefs, sexual preference, marital status, or disability. The Department of Human Services welcomes individuals with disabilities in all its OST programs. Community Schools Bus Policy

The Community School Programs offer afterschool enrichment classes in every elementary school in Cambridge. Most children attend the classes at the Community School located in their school building. Some families prefer to have their children attend classes in the school building located in their neighborhood. If an established bus route exists from a child's school to the preferred Community School, very often the Cambridge Public Schools are able to transport children to that Community School. Parents/guardians need to make transportation arrangements with the Cambridge Public Schools.

In an effort to support families, beginning this year a staff person from Community Schools will be available in front of the school to greet children under the age of 9 arriving by bus and will escort them into the school. Children age 9 and older who have parental permission may enter the school on their own.

To avoid disrupting ongoing classes and to support children's full participation in the enrichment classes, children must arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of Community School Program and no later than 1 hour past the program start time. Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten students will walked down to the cafeteria by classroom staff. Students will be met in the cafeteria by the Fitzgerald Community School staff, take attendance, have snack and then escorted to our child friendly classrooms for programming with their core age group, 4, 5 and 6 year olds. The Kindergartens will have dedicated lead staff and assistants who are with them for all their specialist classes and transitions, until families pick up at the end of the day.

The program will have Creative Choices with a sign up options of one, two or three hours, with specialist classes mixed in and plenty of outdoor fun, gym time, arts, music, block and Lego building in the classroom, dramatic play, read alouds, playdough, quiet books, puzzles and math games.

The KINDER CARE GROUP price is \$120 for each 1 hour class per session. The children will be included in all special events and activities. Early Release Day programs are available with an additional fee of \$45 per afternoon.
